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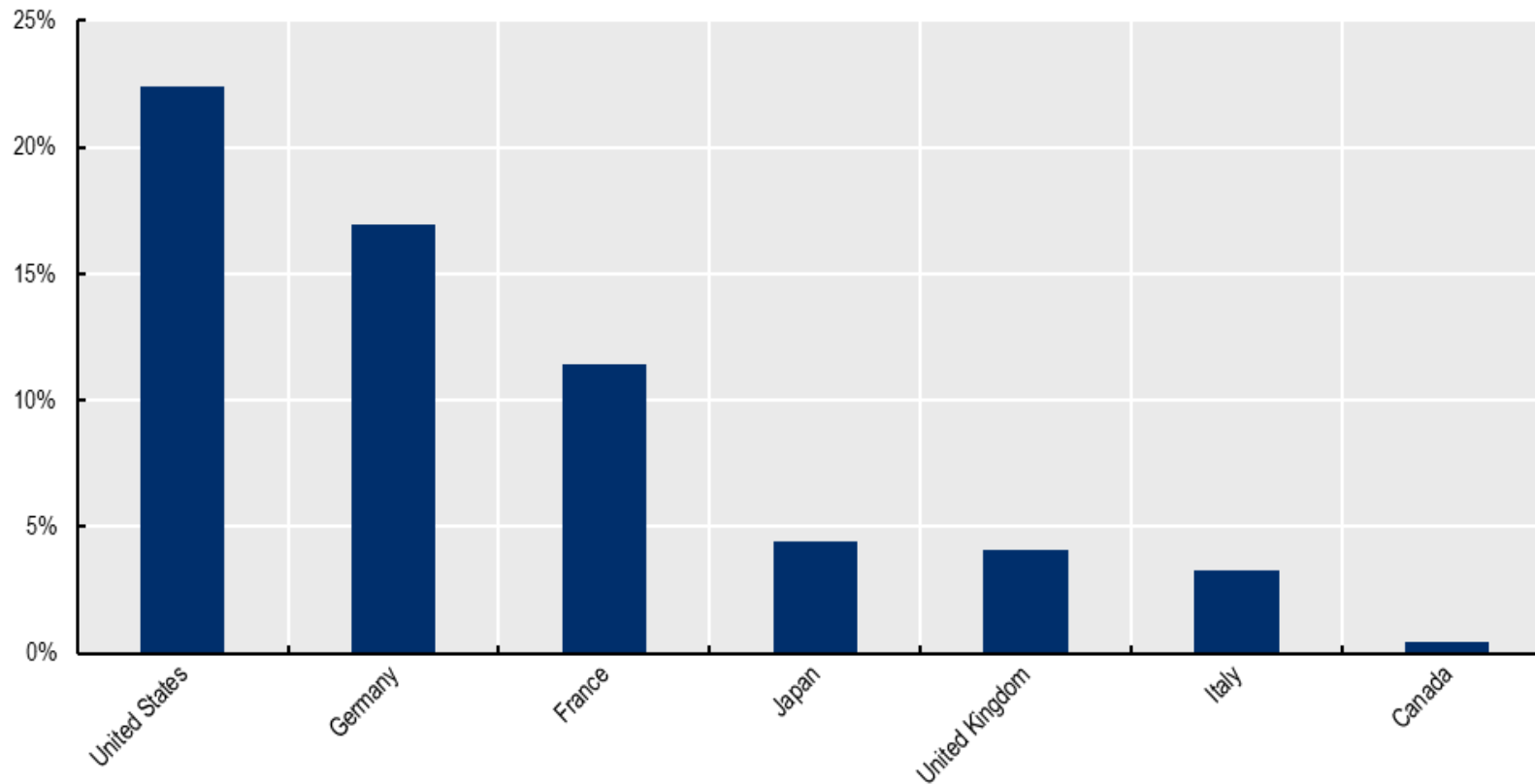
» The Russian aggression could affect global cereal markets substantially

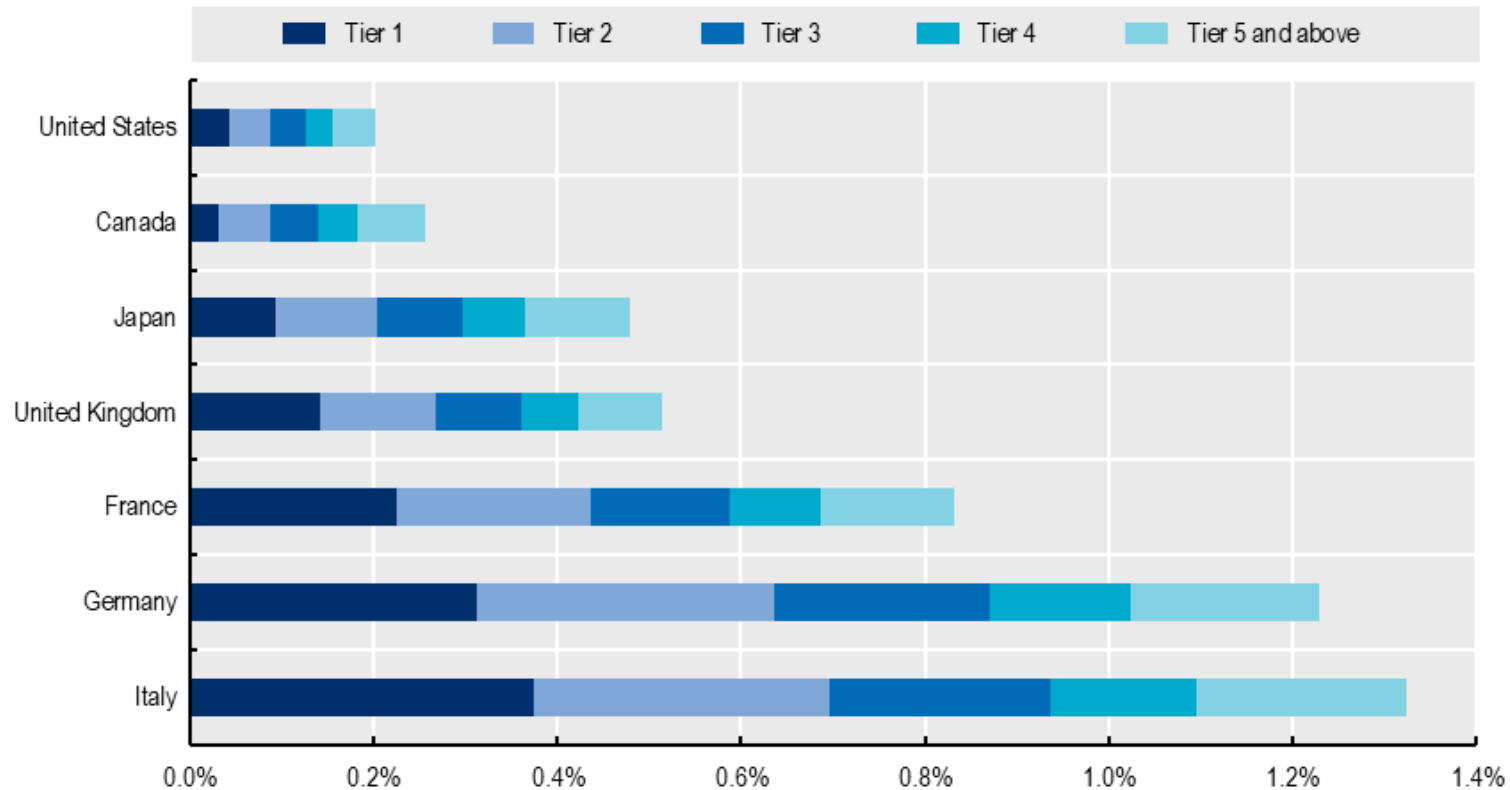

Share of G7 countries in the production of foreign affiliates established in Russia



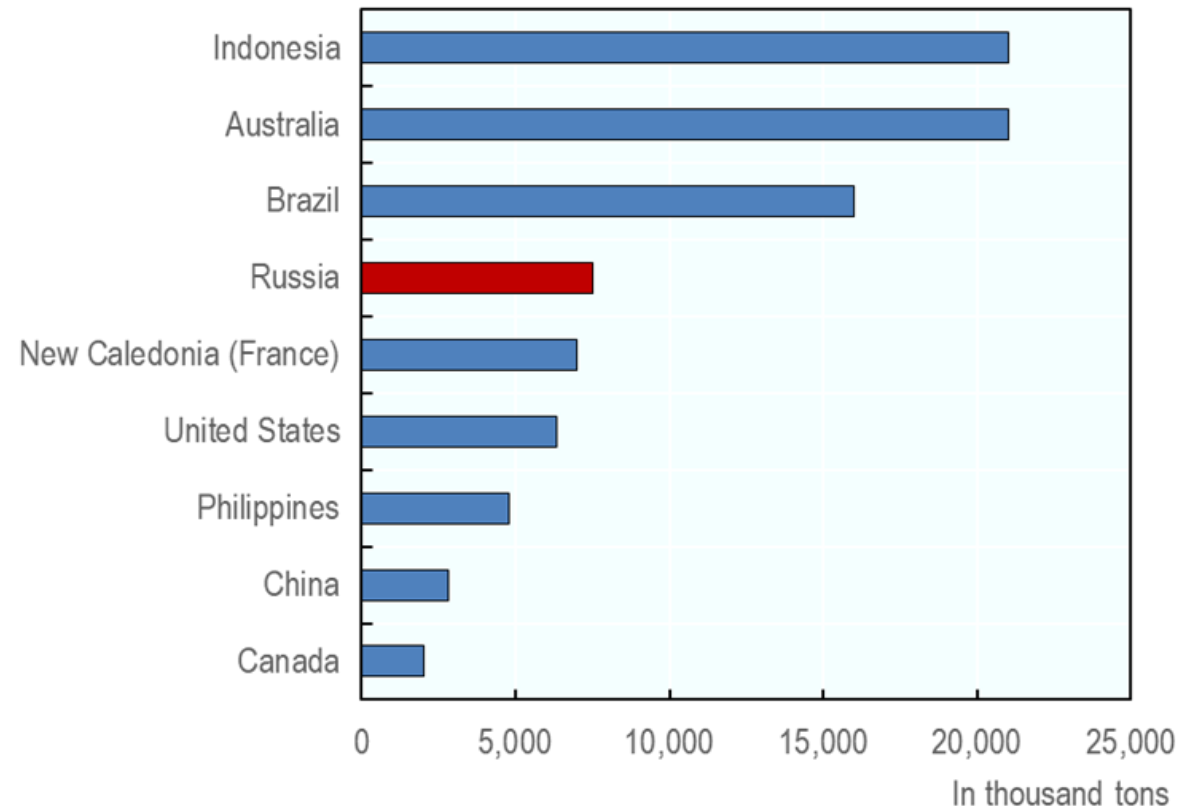
